

All-Terrain Vehicle Route 2012-3

Town of Hamburg, Marathon County

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES ROUTES AND REGULATING THE OPERATION OF ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES

Section I – Intent

The Town of Hamburg, Marathon County adopts the following all-terrain vehicle route for the operation of all-terrain vehicles upon the roadways listed in Section III.

Following due consideration of the recreational value to connect trail opportunities and weighted against possible dangers, public health, liability aspects, terrain involved, traffic density and history of automobile traffic, this route(s) has been created.

Section II – Statutory Authority

This route is created pursuant to village authority under section 1.1.01 as authorized by 23.33 (8) (b), Wis. Stats.

The applicable provisions of 23.33 regulating ATV operation pursuant to routes are adopted.

Section III – Routes

The following roads are designated as routes

- A. 3rd Lane in its entirety
- B. 5th Lane in its entirety
- C. 6th Lane in its entirety
- D. 7th Lane in its entirety
- E. 9th Lane in its entirety
- F. 11th Lane in its entirety
- G. 12th Lane in its entirety
- H. 13th Lane in its entirety

- I. Lincoln Drive in its entirety
- J. Washington Drive in its entirety
- K. Naugart Drive in its entirety
- L. Rainbow Drive in its entirety
(please note that North Lane and County Line Road are not designated routes)

Section IV – Conditions

As a condition for the use of this route, the following conditions shall apply to all operators (and passengers);

- A. All ATV operators must have head lamps and tail lamps on.
- B. All ATV operators must ride single file.
- C. All ATV operators must slow the vehicle to 10-mph or less when operating within 150 feet of a dwelling or 100 feet from a pedestrian or non-motorized vehicle.
- D. All ATV operators must properly display current registration decal for Public Use.
- E. Routes must be signed in accordance with NR 64.12, and NR 64.12(7)c.

Section V – Enforcement

This ordinance shall be enforced by any law enforcement officer authorized to enforce the laws of the state of Wisconsin.

Section VI – Penalties

Wisconsin state All-Terrain Vehicle penalties as found in s. 23.33 (13) (a) Wis. States., are adopted by reference.

Section VII - Severability

The provision of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the County/Town/City/Village would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the

application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons circumstances shall not be deemed affected.

Section VIII – Effective Date

This ordinance becomes effective upon passage and publication.


