

ORDINANCE 2024-1

ORDINANCE FOR UTILITY WORK IN TOWN RIGHT OF WAY

THE TOWN OF HAMBURG DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1. Authority**

This ordinance is adopted pursuant to the powers granted under Wisconsin Constitution. Further, this ordinance is adopted pursuant to the powers granted to the town board under the grant of village powers pursuant to Sec. 60.22 of Wis. Statutes for the protection of public health and safety.


**Section 2. Purpose**


The purpose of this ordinance is to be aware of and oversee any utility work performed within the town road right of way by any such person, persons or companies contracted by such authority to install, maintain and or repair power, phone, gas, broadband cable or similar items that may reside in, under or above the town road right of way. Permission will be granted by consulting with the Board at any of the regularly scheduled monthly Town Board meetings or in case of an emergency repair, contacting the Town Chairperson or one of the Town Supervisors.


**Section 3. Effective Date**

This ordinance is effective the day after publication.


